The Mustard Seed is looking to hire 40 full-time shelter support staff for our new Commonwealth and Wetaskiwin shelters at our Hiring Fair on December 6.

Front-line staff work directly with community members experiencing homelessness or poverty. A Shelter Support Worker works closely with The Mustard Seed's participants accessing the Shelter Program, encouraging and supporting them in their journey and directing them to The Mustard Seed's programs and services. Shelter Support Worker's respond to participant needs on an ongoing basis and ensure they are supported and cared for.

Attendees will need to bring proof of eligibility to work in Canada and proof of vaccination.
